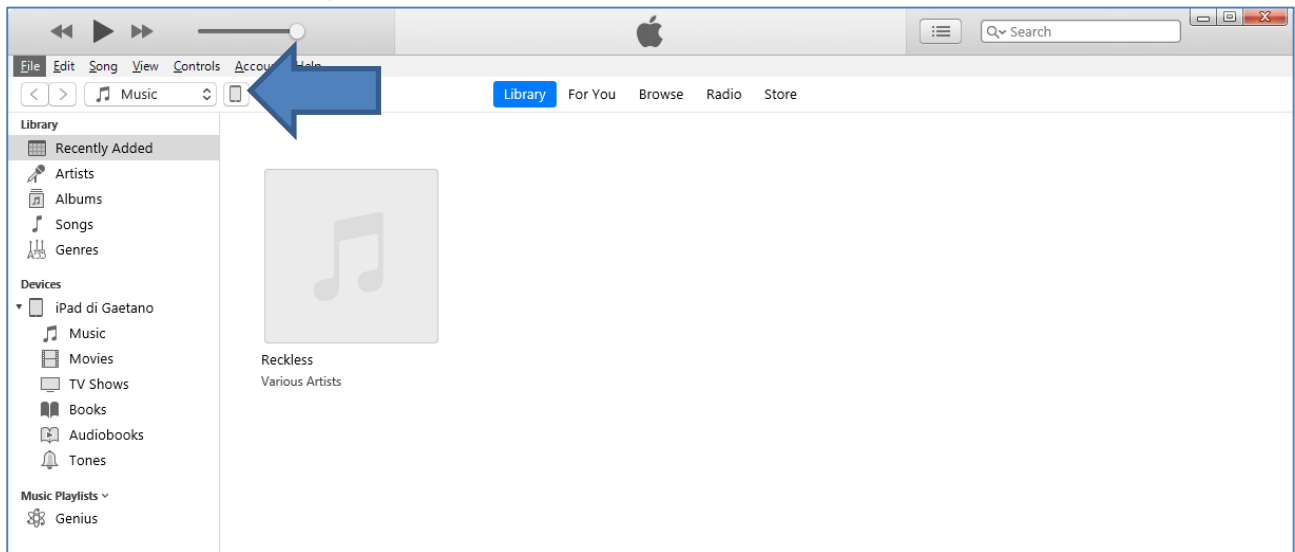
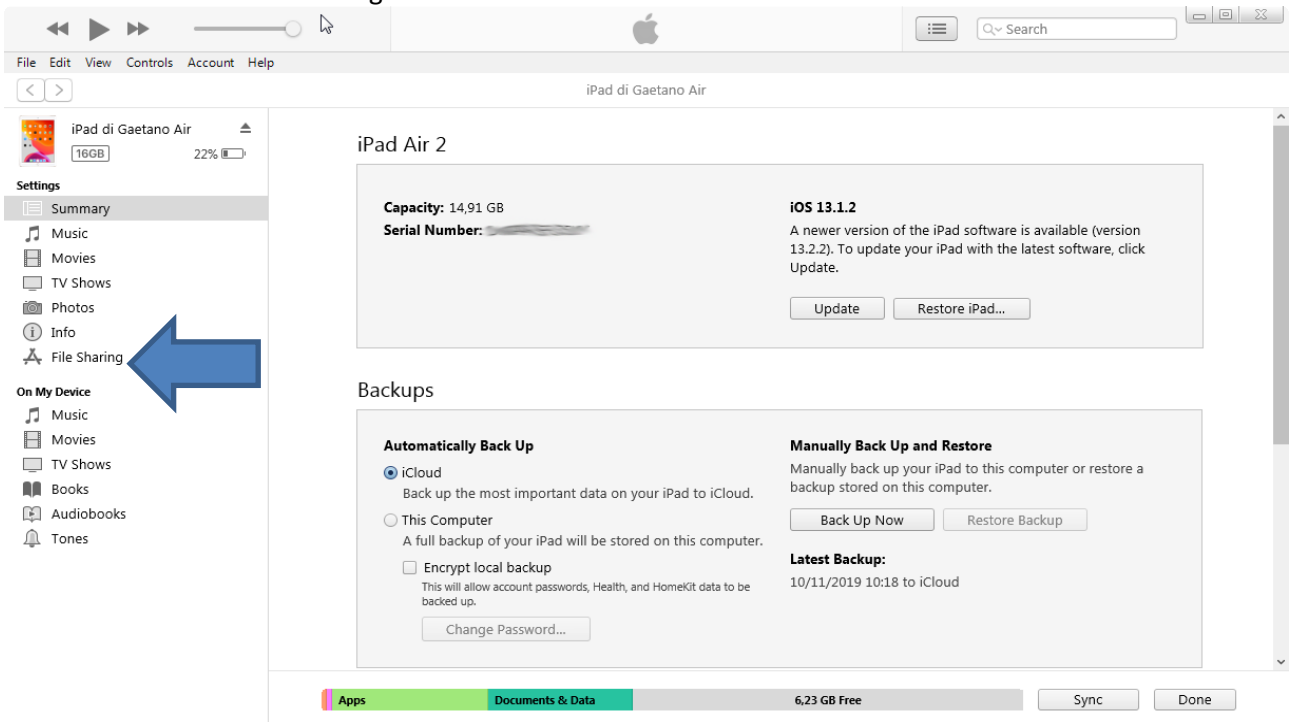


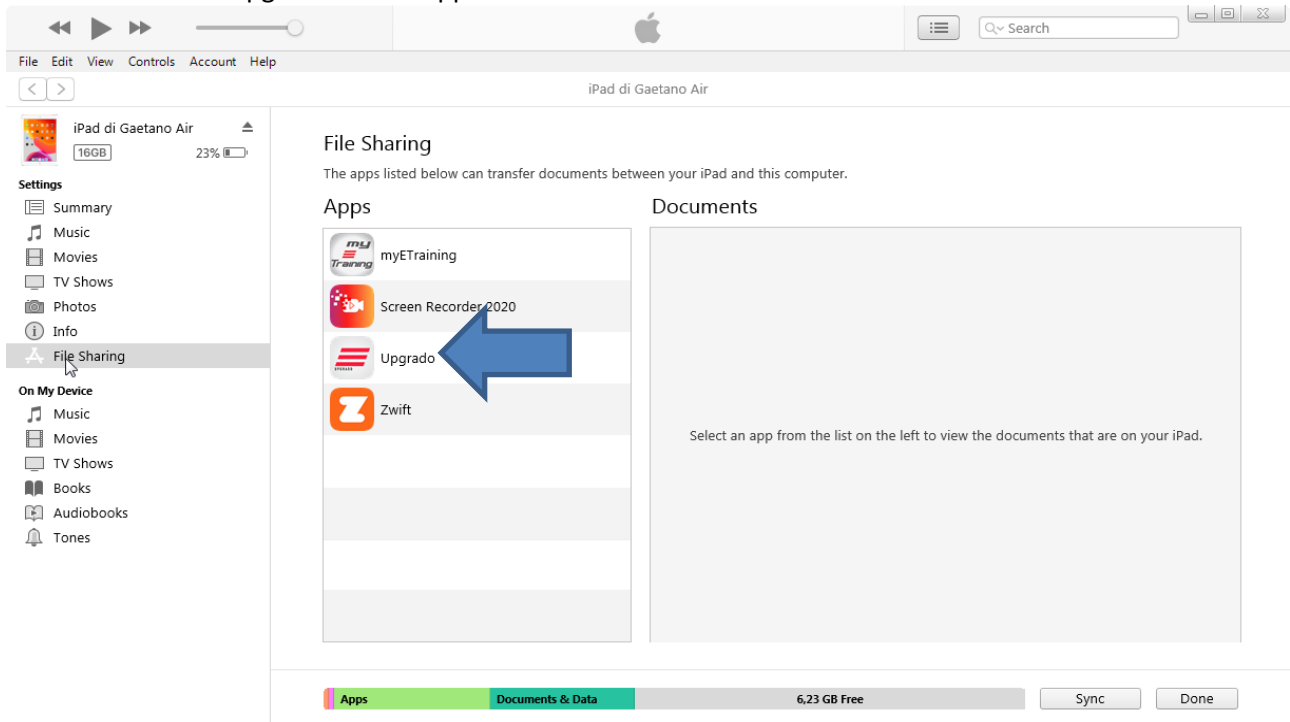
- Connect the device to the computer and launch iTunes.
- Click on the iPhone/iPad icon.



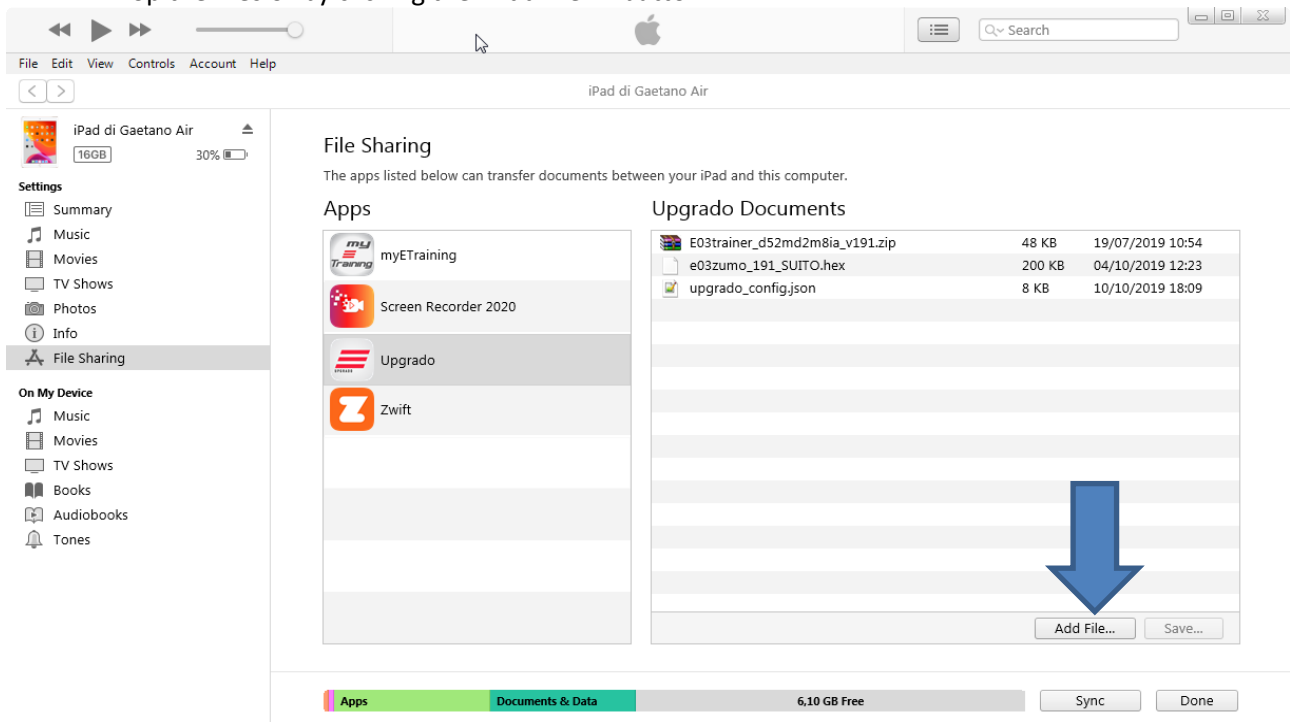
- Click on the File Sharing.
